What is Multimedia

- Using a variety of media content to present information
 - Combining text, graphic images, audio, and/or video
 - Displayed via a computer
- The combined use of media, such as movies, music, lighting, CD-ROMs, and the Internet, as for education or entertainment.

- The use of several different <u>media</u> to convey information (<u>text</u>, <u>audio</u>, <u>graphics</u>, <u>animation</u>, <u>video</u>, and <u>interactivity</u>) Wikepedia

Using PowerPoint for Multimedia

- One presentation can display multiple media elements
 - Text
 - Photos
 - Video clips
 - Sound
 - Music
 - Voice
 - Charts and graphs
 - Drawn objects

 - Excel, Word





PowerPoint Tips

Text

- Use large, blocky text
- Sans-serif
- High contrast between text color and background
- Limit amount of text

Serif text
San-serif text

Poor contrast

Avoid writing out paragraphs of text. Too much text will distract viewers from what you are saying or will not be understood.

Backgrounds

- Keep simple
- Light backgrounds with dark text are easier to see in darkened room
- Avoid busy details
- Make your own

Backgrounds

- This background competes with the text
- Use less detailed backgrounds or bring down the color intensity and contrast level

Photos

- Crop out extraneous material
- Size
- Consider a border
- Adjust brightness& contrast
